



## May Half Term Holiday Club FAQ's

- **Q) Is the club Ofsted registered?**  
A) At present the club is not Ofsted registered. Although if we were to continue with the club post May half term, we would certainly look at getting the club registered.
- **Q) Do you accept childcare vouchers or tax-free payments?**  
A) Until the club is Ofsted registered, we will be unable to accept any child care voucher or tax-free payments.
- **Q) If the timings I require start from 09:00 onwards, would I still need to pay the full £4 price for the early drop off?**  
A) Yes - if you require to drop your child prior to the standard day start time of 09:30, you will need to pay for the early drop off part of the day. You can choose what time you arrive within the early drop off, if you have paid for it. Anyone booked on the standard day will be signed in from 09:30 onwards.
- **Q) What activities will take place?**  
A) A variety of sport specific games and physical activity including things such as dodgeball, creative movement, football and 'capture the flag'. As well as arts, crafts and Lego during the quieter times in the day for those who wish to use it. There is normally a daily planner for events which the children can view upon arrival. We often try to give children two options when playing a sport e.g. Football or creative movements.
- **Q) Will the activities be free flowing?**  
A) During early drop off and late pick up sessions, children will be given the option to move freely between designated activities pre-set by staff, such as the Trim Track, Lego, arts and crafts and physical activity (similar to before school club during term time). These options may differ per day based on the number of attendees and the staff on site. During the standard day, children will be placed into age specific groups and they will participate in set activities led by the EdActive staff.
- **Q) Will there be a tuck shop available?**  
A) No - there will not be an opportunity on site to purchase additional food items. We strongly recommend your child has plenty of healthy food options to keep them fuelled throughout the day.
- **Q) Will my child need a packed lunch?**  
A) Yes - please provide your child with a packed lunch and plenty of healthy snacks for them to have during our morning and afternoon snack break. No nuts or products containing nuts are allowed. Plenty of water in a refillable bottle is recommended. No fizzy drinks are allowed.



- **Q) Where do I drop my children off?**

A) Pick up and drop off will be from the school hall. If driving to the site, please ensure you use the parent and visitor car park. As the school office is closed there will be no access via the Burnside entrance to ensure the security of the site and the children throughout the day.

- **Q) Can my child walk to and from the club independently?**

A) Providing you send an email to [info@edactive.co.uk](mailto:info@edactive.co.uk) giving your child's name and DOB along with written permission for them to walk, then we will dismiss them at the end of their session to walk home.

- **Q) Can my child bring their phone?**

A) Only if the child needs it for drop off and pick up purposes. Phones will be kept in a secure place with EdActive staff for the duration of the day.

- **Q) What should my child wear?**

A) Suitable sports clothing and footwear. Please consider the weather and provide items such as sun hat and cream or waterproof jacket if applicable.
