Communication between School and Home

Here's a reminder of what you need to know:

 SchoolGrid → a SchoolGrid account is essential if your child has a school meal. Meals need to pre-booked by a Parent in advance or by 8:55am at the latest, on the day it is required.



- 2. **Teachers2Parents** \rightarrow this is used:
 - to book Before School Club sessions (previously known as Breakfast Club). Please pay online through the app or by card at the office as we are now cashless.
 - to purchase a book bag/drawstring bag (not available through SkoolKit) and P.E. sweatshirts (whilst stocks last).
 - to pay for any chargeable activities i.e. Year 6 residential.
 - to send parents/carers text messages or emails with information, reminders about events previously communicated in newsletters and links to information on our website etc.
- 3. QI Newsletter → information applicable to the whole school which is sent out via Teachers2Parents on the last working day of each month.
- 4. Year Group Newsletter → year group specific information sent out via the Year Group email at the start of each half term.
- QI website → this is kept up-to-date and holds a wealth of information including an up-to-date calendar of events, After School Club/Holiday Club info and feedback/booking forms and questionnaires via the '<u>Contact Us</u>' page etc.
- Year Group Emails → used for direct communication between teachers and parents. Teachers do not check emails during the school day so if you have an urgent message, please contact the school office adminoffice@queensinclosure.hants.sch.uk / 02392 268067 rather than email the teacher.

We put a lot of time and effort into our written communications, which are the primary source of information for our Parents/Carers, so please, please make every effort to read them. We also ask that, to avoid disappointment or embarrassment, you meet the deadlines we set, as late requests add additional workload to our extremely busy team and cannot always be accommodated. 
General Information

Cornelius Gate/Car Park is open from 7:40am to 7:00pm.


If you are not attending Before School Club, please wait at the Stop Point until **8:30am and 3:15pm**, when you can then walk round to your child's class.
